Cyclist Dies In Morning Crash HASTINGS - Brian Hamilton, 22, of Bidwell Road Parish was pronounced dead on arrival at Oswego Hospital early Saturday after a motorcycle accident in the Town of Hastings. According to the Oswego County Sheriff's Department Hamilton was operating a motorcycle on County Route 32 at about 2:25 a.m. when he failed to negotiate curve and his vehicle struck a group of trees and a fence. A passenger on the cycle, Thomas Schill, 22, of Hastings was injured and taken to Crouse-Irving Hospital in Syracuse. Hamilton was a 1978 graduate of Parish Central School.
