



Stanley August

A 21-year-old Parish motorcyclist was killed in the village of Mexico early this morning when he lost control and slammed head-on into a tractor trailer. Stanley August, 21, was declared dead on arrival at Oswego Hospital suffering multiple internal injuries, according to Sheriff's deputies. Deputy Wes Belcher reported that August was driving on Rte. 104 just east of Pulaski St. at 1:10 a.m. when he crossed the road's center line and hit a tractor trailer rig operated by Peter Tierney, 34, of Chittenango. Anoint was elected from his motorcycle which burst into flames. The victim was pinned under the front wheels of the truck before being removed and transported to the hospital. The truck driver was not injured. The Sheriff's department report indicates that August may have suffered a physical ailment or mechanical troubles just before the accident. Tierney, the truck driver, told deputies that the motorcycle was wobbling prior to the accident and had tipped over just before the impact.
