



George J. Van Antwerp - Troop G

On August 23, 1934, Trooper George J. Van Antwerp, 30, died in Cohoes Hospital a few hours after his motorcycle collided with a car on the Albany-Crescent Road, (present day Route 9 near Bought Corners).

Trooper Van Antwerp was following a vehicle northbound and as he attempted to pass, the vehicle made a left turn into his path. He sustained a fractured skull, internal injuries and a severe leg injury.

Trooper Van Antwerp was assigned to Troop "G" at the time of his death. During his five years with the State Police, he served in Troop "K" at Scarsdale and at Speculator, Scotia and the Troy Posts of Troop "G".
