Mr. Joseph F. Joe Arcuri, age 30, of Marcy, passed away on Sunday, May 6, 2012, at the Roswell Park Cancer Institute in Buffalo with his loving family by his side, after a long and courageous battle with leukemia. Joseph was born in Liverpool, NY, on March 7, 1982, the son of Joseph F. and Regina (Restive) Arcuri. He was a graduate of Liverpool High School and continued his academic studies at MVCC, where he received an associate's degree in mechanical technology. He went on to graduate from SUNY Institute of Technology/Class of 2004, where he earned a Bachelor of Science in mechanical engineering. On September 6, 2008, he married the former Noelle G. Buczek; the couple shared a very supportive and loving union. During his college years, Joe worked at the Fountainhead Group, where he helped design industrial sprayers. He worked as a design engineer at Magna Powertrain, Inc., in East Syracuse.
