OLD FORGE - A Dexter, N.Y. man died from massive skull fractures after losing control of his motorcycle on South Shore Road September 10, 2006 according to Town of Webb police. Roger E. Brown, 52, was heading southbound on South Shore Road when he lost control on a right hand curve, police said. Witnesses said Brown went into the northbound lane and as he applied the front brake, the front skidded out, causing him to be thrown from the motorcycle, police said. The Old Forge Ambulance responded to the accident and transported Brown to Saint Elizabeth Medical Center, where he was pronounced dead at 2:40 p.m., police said. Roger worked for 21 ½ years at Nine Mile Two Power Plant, Oswego.
