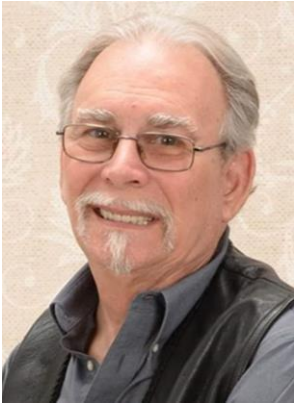




## Julius “Jay” Jensen
