



Thomas L. "Torque" Hollingsworth Sr.



Thomas L. Hollingsworth Sr., of Munnsville, died Wednesday, July 28, 2010, in Crouse Community Center, Morrisville. Born in Peterboro on March 15, 1921, he was the son of Raymond G. and Anna May Hoyt Hollingsworth. A lifelong resident of the area, he attended the Peterboro, Stockbridge and Oneida Schools. He married Mary Louise O'Brien in Oneida, on February 5, 1943. Mrs. Hollingsworth died Nov. 30, 1993. Prior to his retirement, Mr. Hollingsworth was employed with Oneida Limited Silversmiths.

He was a member of the Munnsville American Legion, Post No. 54, the American Legion Riders, Post No. 54 and was an avid stock car fan and drove stock cars in the 1940's and 1950's. Mr. Hollingsworth was a veteran of World War II serving with the United States Army.
